- ✓ Innovative or creative approaches solving community issues
- ✓ Demonstrate strong involvement in community affairs
- ✓ Demonstrate personal values
- ✓ Effective leadership

Green Award

The Green Award will be awarded to a non-profit or business that has incorporated green practices

- ✓ Results should be quantifiable and substantial
- ✓ Practices must be year-round, not just for Earth Day
- ✓ Extra consideration given for efforts that include everyone, from the top management down
